

## Krewe of Wrecks Parade Rules

Any infringement of these rules can result in your being ejected from the parade.

1. Drivers must be sober. It is recommended drivers not consume any alcoholic beverages 8 hours prior to the parade, per Florida Statute. No open containers allowed in tow vehicle. Parade participants are advised to use good judgment during the parade by not drinking to excess. Do not display alcohol containers. Use paper or plastic cups. **DO NOT LITTER.**
2. Every Float is required to provide throws. Throw moon pies, trinkets, and beads (**NO CANDY**) far into the crowd, to help keep the children out of the road. Be careful not to allow throws to fall between the floats.
3. **SAFETY WALKERS (SPOTTERS) ARE A MUST.** A spotter must be at each axle of the float as well as the tow vehicle. Spotters are required to be at least 18 years of age, be sober, and wear an approved security vest (orange preferred). **SPOTTERS CANNOT DRINK DURING PARADE.**
4. No animals will be allowed to parade.
5. No one under the age of 18 will be allowed to be a walker with their Krewe in the parade.
6. Floats will **NOT** stop at the reviewing stand. You may pass slowly and smile.
7. Maintain a safe distance between floats. Stay within the barricades. If your vehicle breaks down, signal the float behind you to proceed around you. Drive safely and keep up with the float in front of you. **DO NOT LAG.**
8. Police cruisers will be at the front of the parade and police security will run the entire route providing spectator control and safety.
9. No oversized tow trucks allowed. No motorcycles allowed. No pickup trucks allowed unless pulling a float.
10. Those bringing a float over on Saturday must park in the Pier parking lot and check in at the Sheriff's sub-station. These floats must depart the parking lot for check-in and lineup before 10am Sunday.
11. All floats are to go to the first parking lot past Sugar Bowl, turn around, and line up in the west-bound lane of Via De Luna. Check-in begins at 10am and ends at noon. All floats will line up in order of arrival.
12. Parade rolls **PROMPTLY** at 2pm. The parade route starts at Via De Luna and Avenida 10, proceeds west in the northern-most lane of Via De Luna to the Sidelines entrance of Casino Beach and ends in the pier parking lot near the Sheriff's substation. **PLEASE FOLLOW DIRECTIONS OF SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES. \***
13. Floats will stay in the pier parking lot until officials give permission to leave.
14. Before leaving the pier parking lot, make sure all boxes are broken down and all trash picked up and placed in containers. Put someone in charge of policing around your float.
15. All floats must leave after the awards ceremony.

\* Quiet Zone – At end of parade, music and loud noises will stop at the Public Safety Building, so that drivers can hear & understand deputies.
